## June 2021 - Joslyn Center Update

It's finally happening! Barring any major backslide, the Joslyn Recreation Center will be reopening along with the rest of the State of California in about 2 weeks on June 15<sup>th</sup>! If you haven't seen our reopening FAQ, please take a look at this short document on our website. We are currently showing a 3-month calendar of which clubs are expected to be using the facility when; that will switch back to a monthly format at the end of June (displaying only July). I know that some people will need time to decide what they are comfortable doing in a multi-use community center just after quarantine restrictions are lifted, while others are itching to do everything (or more) that they did 16 months ago. She's also available by phone and e-mail to work on scheduling needs, etc.

## **Indoor Maintenance Update**

As a reminder, some work has been done by the county in the building while we were away, but there is more that they are going to do. The new restroom floors look terrific.
