### **Lawn Bowls Tourney Coming Up**

It's tournament time for Cambria Lawn Bowls Club. On the heels of two extremely successful tournaments in 2021, it's time for a repeat. On March 26 & 27 we will once again host world class bowlers from southern and northern California in a Rinks tournament.

Rinks is a form of lawn bowls where you have two teams per game with 4 players to a team rolling two bowls per player. It's more challenging than pairs (4 bowls) in that you only get two bowls to draw near the jack (little target ball). The bowler has fewer opportunities for adjustments to their roll. Bowlers will play three games in a round robin on Saturday. Their

game wins and scores will be calculated, and on Sunday they will be assigned to the championship flight or the consolation flight.

We'd love to have you drop in at the Joslyn Center, 950 W. Main St., watching the bowlers on Saturday or Sunday between 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Our members will be out there wearing our new club shirts. Any of them will be happy to explain the happenings on the green. (Please don't interrupt the tournament participants during play.) Stay for a short time, or longer and maybe you'll get hooked. We will have membership applications available if you'd like to join our club. (Membership in the CLBC also requires a membership to the Joslyn Center.)
