Joslyn Adult Recreation Center – Art on Walls Policy

(Updated April 2022)

The Joslyn Center board wants to encourage members to show original pieces of art on in the main hall. The policies for doing so are summarized in Q&A fashion below. If you have questions, please e-mail JoslynCenter@JoslynRec.org.

Q: How many artists can be shown?

A: We have room for 7 or 8 artists to show their work simultaneously without overcrowding the walls.

Q: How many pieces can each artist show?

A: Every JRC member artist may choose up to 3 of their pieces to display.

Q: How long can the artwork stay up?

A: We would like pieces to remain in place no longer than 3 months at a time, then be rotated out for other items to keep the look inside fresh over time.

Q: Can an artist keep rotating their work displayed indefinitely?

A: Artists who have had works up for 6 months or more may be asked to allow other artists to have an opportunity to put their pieces up so that we have a varied set of providers, but if there is no additional demand to display other artist's works, there is no time limit per artist.

Q: Is there a cost to display art pieces?

A: We ask only that a minimum of 20% of any sale be donated to the Joslyn Center as commission (feel free to give more if a piece is sold while displayed in the JRC).
