## **August 2021 – Joslyn Center Update**

Most clubs are now back up and running in some form. Not all are back to the same schedule or completely in person yet but there's no hurry. If your club needs any help arranging use of the facility, Peg in the office is doing a fabulous job of scheduling and assisting with our return to utilizing the Joslyn Center fully. **IMPORTANT:** The County is finally ready to do repair work on various parts of the building as a result of problems we had during the big rain storm last January. Beginning Aug 2<sup>nd</sup>, you may see/hear workers up on the roof but they shouldn't affect any club's use of the center. However, on Aug 9<sup>th</sup>, work will start in the restrooms and back storage area. Especially during the beginning of the week, access to these locations may be limited or completely unavailable for hours at a time (until 5pm). By later in the week, we expect that members should be able to ask workers for quick access to all rooms where significant work is taking place, but we don't know exactly how the effort will progress. If you are planning to attend a club function on Monday or Tuesday (Aug 9 or 10) during the day, there's a very good chance you may not have quick restroom access. Those of you who require (nearly) immediate restroom access may want to consider skipping Joslyn activities until the "all clear" has been sent to your club presidents (from me based on County input). Sorry about the inconvenience but the work is badly needed and the county is driving the scheduling since they are providing the contracted help to do it.
